BAFS

(I) Aims

To nurture students' interest and talent in business by developing their knowledge and skills, positive values and attitude.

To develop students' understanding on the purpose of accounting in business.

To establish a favourable environment for promoting lifelong learning

(II) Situational Analysis

(a) Strengths

- (i) An attractive and clear career path can attract students to study this subject.
- (ii) Students find the subject interesting and useful in learning more about the business world.

(b) Weaknesses

- (i) Supplementary lessons during holidays need to be arranged for the demanding syllabus. However, NSS students have to attend supplementary lessons of different subjects during holidays which cause a low effectiveness.
- (ii) There is not enough manpower to carry out large-scale activities, to attend different seminars, to look for different teaching materials and to share teaching experience

(c) Opportunities

- (i) BAFS widely covers commercial and business activities, its attractiveness is enhanced.
- (ii) As the syllabus of the subject has been modified significantly, students have more time to prepare well for the HKSDE.
- (iii) The lesson time increased from 4 lessons in a 7-day cycle to 5 lessons in a 8-day cycle would help the learning and teaching process.
- (iv) Due to the change of S3 streaming system, more students would be enrolled in BAFS according to their preferences.

(d) Threats

- (i) As the syllabus of the subject has been modified significantly, both students and teacher need more time to familiar with the new syllabus.
- (ii) There are a total of 33 students (most students among the electives) rolled in the coming S4, the diversity could be forecasted.
