


Pittsburgh shooting: (1) casualties at Squirrel Hill synagogue
Eleven people have been killed, officials say, in a gun attack on a synagogue in the US city of Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania.
The gunman, who opened (2) as the Tree of Life synagogue held a service, was later taken into custody .
President Donald Trump called it a "wicked act of (3) murder".
The suspect, who has been officially identified as Robert Bowers, 46, was injured and is receiving treatment.
Two other people are in hospital in a (4) condition, police said.
Federal investigators are treating the shooting as a hate (5) Pittsburgh FBI's special agent in charge of the (6), Bob Jones, told a press conference that Mr Bowers did not appear to be known to authorities prior to events on Saturday. He said that any (7) remains unknown but that authorities believe he was acting alone.
The Anti-Defamation League, a Jewish non-governmental organisation that fights anti-Semitism, said: "We believe this is the deadliest attack on the Jewish (8) in the history of the United States."
Hundreds of people - from the neighbourhood and also all across Pittsburgh - later gathered for an interfaith vigil for the victims of the attack.
